CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Budget and Management – Health and Welfare Benefits**
3 **Program – Information from and Liability of Health Insurance Carriers**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain health insurance carriers to provide certain
5 information in a certain manner to the Department of Budget and Management,
6 at the request of the Department, about individuals who are eligible for benefits
7 under the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program or
8 are Program recipients; requiring certain health insurance carriers to accept the
9 Program's right of recovery and the assignment to the Program of certain rights
10 under certain circumstances; prohibiting certain health insurance carriers from
11 denying or otherwise affecting a health insurance policy or contract due to the
12 eligibility of an individual for Program benefits or receipt by an individual of
13 benefits under the Program; defining a certain term; and generally relating to
14 health insurance carriers and the State Employee and Retiree Health and
15 Welfare Benefits Program.

2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 **Article - Health - General**

5 19-706.

6 **(PPP) THE PROVISIONS OF § 2-517 OF THE STATE PERSONNEL AND**
7 **PENSIONS ARTICLE APPLY TO HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.**

8 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

9 **2-517.**

10 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, "CARRIER" MEANS:**

11 **(1) A HEALTH INSURER;**

12 **(2) A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN;**

13 **(3) A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION; AND**

14 **(4) A DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATION.**

15 **(B) (1) A CARRIER SHALL PROVIDE, AT THE REQUEST OF THE**
16 **DEPARTMENT, INFORMATION ABOUT INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR**
17 **BENEFITS UNDER THE PROGRAM OR ARE PROGRAM RECIPIENTS SO THAT THE**
18 **DEPARTMENT MAY DETERMINE WHETHER THE INDIVIDUAL IS RECEIVING**
19 **HEALTH CARE COVERAGE FROM THE CARRIER AND THE NATURE OF THAT**
20 **COVERAGE.**

21 **(2) A CARRIER SHALL PROVIDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED**
22 **UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN**
23 **ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD DATA ELEMENTS FOR STANDARD**
24 **TRANSACTIONS REQUIRED UNDER 42 U.S.C. § 1320D-4 AS ADOPTED BY THE**
25 **SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.**

26 **(C) A CARRIER SHALL ACCEPT THE PROGRAM'S RIGHT OF RECOVERY**
27 **AND THE ASSIGNMENT TO THE PROGRAM OF ANY RIGHT OF AN INDIVIDUAL OR**
28 **OTHER ENTITY TO PAYMENT FROM THE CARRIER FOR AN ITEM OR SERVICE FOR**
29 **WHICH PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE UNDER THE PROGRAM IF THE CARRIER HAS A**
30 **LEGAL OBLIGATION TO MAKE PAYMENT FOR THE ITEM OR SERVICE.**

1 (D) A CARRIER MAY NOT REJECT, DENY, LIMIT, CANCEL, REFUSE TO
2 RENEW, INCREASE THE RATES OF, AFFECT THE TERMS OR CONDITIONS OF, OR
3 OTHERWISE AFFECT A HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY OR CONTRACT FOR A
4 REASON BASED WHOLLY OR PARTLY ON:

5 (1) THE ELIGIBILITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL TO RECEIVE BENEFITS
6 UNDER THE PROGRAM; OR

7 (2) THE RECEIPT BY AN INDIVIDUAL OF BENEFITS UNDER THE
8 PROGRAM.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 June 1, 2008.
