## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Teachers' Pension System - Ineligible Positions - Transferring Membership

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain members of the Teachers' Pension System to transfer to the Employees' Pension System under certain circumstances; 4 5 allowing certain members of the Teachers' Pension System the choice of whether to transfer to the Employees' Pension System or a local pension system; 6 7 requiring certain members of the Teachers' Pension System to make certain 8 choices at a certain time; requiring certain employers of certain members of the 9 Teachers' Pension System to make certain contributions to the Board of 10 Trustees of the State Retirement and Pension System on behalf of the members; clarifying that certain provisions of law apply to certain transfers of certain 11 members of the Teachers' Pension System to a local pension system; providing 12 13 for the application of this Act; and generally relating to members of the Teachers' Pension System who are promoted or transferred to positions that are 14 not eligible for participation in the Teachers' Pension System. 15

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
  - Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 24 23–202.1.

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1 (A) A nonfaculty employee of the Baltimore City Community College who is a member of the Teachers' Pension System on October 1, 2002 may transfer membership to the Employees' Pension System on or before December 31, 2002.

## (B) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

- 5 (I) IS A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM;
- 6 AND

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- 7 (II) IS PROMOTED OR TRANSFERRED TO A POSITION THAT IS
- 8 NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM BUT IS
- 9 ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM.
- 10 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS
- 11 SUBSECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
- 12 SUBSECTION SHALL TRANSFER MEMBERSHIP TO THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION
- 13 SYSTEM AT THE TIME THE INDIVIDUAL IS PROMOTED OR TRANSFERRED.
- 14 (3) (I) 1. AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF
- 15 THIS SUBSECTION WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER THAT
- 16 HAS ESTABLISHED A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL
- 17 EMPLOYED IN THE NEW POSITION WOULD QUALIFY SHALL CHOOSE WHETHER
- 18 TO TRANSFER MEMBERSHIP TO THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OR THE
- 19 LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM.
- 20 **2. AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL CHOOSE WHETHER TO**
- 21 TRANSFER MEMBERSHIP TO THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OR THE LOCAL
- 22 PENSION SYSTEM AT THE TIME THE MEMBER IS PROMOTED OR TRANSFERRED.
- 23 (II) IF AN INDIVIDUAL CHOOSES TO TRANSFER
- 24 MEMBERSHIP TO THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM, EACH YEAR THE
- 25 INDIVIDUAL'S EMPLOYER SHALL PAY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON BEHALF
- 26 OF THE INDIVIDUAL AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION
- 27 RATE IN EFFECT FOR STATE EMPLOYEES PARTICIPATING IN THE EMPLOYEES'
- 28 **PENSION SYSTEM.**
- 29 (III) IF AN INDIVIDUAL CHOOSES TO TRANSFER
- 30 MEMBERSHIP TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM, TITLE 37 OF THIS
- 31 ARTICLE SHALL APPLY.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and many not be applied or interpreted to have
- any effect on or application to any individual who on or before June 30, 2008, is a
- member of the Teachers' Pension System and employed in a position not eligible for
- 36 participation in the Teachers' Pension System.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  ${ 1 \atop 2 }$ 

July 1, 2008.
