  bicycles when authorized by the Chairman of the Maryland Transportation
  Authority; and generally relating to the use of vehicular crossings.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19Article Transportation
- 20 21-1401.
- 21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) "Approach" means any roadway, overhead structure, ramp, bridge,
causeway, entrance, and exit provided as a means of access to or departure from a
vehicular crossing.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



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1 (c) "Bridge" means any bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland  $\mathbf{2}$ Transportation Authority.

- "Tunnel" means: 3 (d)

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The Baltimore Harbor Tunnel; and (1)

Any other tunnel within the jurisdiction of the Maryland  $\mathbf{5}$ (2)Transportation Authority. 6

7 "Vehicular crossing" means: (e)

Each tunnel and bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland 8 (1)9 Transportation Authority; and

- 10 (2)Each approach to these tunnels and bridges.
- 11 21 - 1405.

12(a) [Pedestrians] UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE 13MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, PEDESTRIANS may not use any vehicular crossing. 14

15(b) [Bicycles] UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE 16 MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, BICYCLES may not use any vehicular 17crossing.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 19 October 1, 2008.

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
