$2\\3\\4$	(b) "Approach" means any roadway, overhead structure, ramp, bridge, causeway, entrance, and exit provided as a means of access to or departure from a vehicular crossing.
5 6	(c) "Bridge" means any bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland Transportation Authority.
7	(d) "Tunnel" means:
8	(1) The Baltimore Harbor Tunnel; and
9 10	(2) Any other tunnel within the jurisdiction of the Maryland Transportation Authority.
11	(e) "Vehicular crossing" means:
12 13	(1) Each tunnel and bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland Transportation Authority; and
14	(2) Each approach to these tunnels and bridges.

16 17 18	(a) [Pedestrians] UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, PEDESTRIANS may not use any vehicular crossing.
19 20 21	(b) [Bicycles] UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, BICYCLES may not use any vehicular crossing.
22 23	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
