# Business Regulation - Returnable Containers - Purchases of Plastic Milk Crates

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain persons that purchase certain plastic milk crates to make a certain record of each transaction in which a person sells a certain 5 6 number of plastic milk crates; requiring certain purchasers to verify the identity 7 of certain sellers in a certain manner; requiring certain purchasers to keep 8 certain records of certain transactions; requiring certain records to be kept for a 9 certain period of time; providing that a person that violates this Act is guilty of 10 a misdemeanor and subject to a certain fine; defining a certain term; and 11 generally relating to purchases of milk crates.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### **Article – Business Regulation**

20 **19–308.** 

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(A) IN THIS SECTION, "PLASTIC MILK CRATE" MEANS A PLASTIC CRATE
OR SHELL USED BY A MILK PRODUCER, DISTRIBUTOR, OR RETAILER, OR AN
AGENT OF A MILK PRODUCER, DISTRIBUTOR, OR RETAILER, AS A MEANS FOR
THE BULK TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE, OR CARRYING OF RETAIL CONTAINERS
OF MILK.

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(1) 1 **(B)** EACH PERSON THAT PURCHASES PLASTIC MILK CRATES,  $\mathbf{2}$ INCLUDING A PERSON THAT IS IN THE BUSINESS OF RECYCLING, SHREDDING, 3 OR DESTRUCTION OF PLASTIC MILK CRATES, SHALL MAKE A WRITTEN RECORD 4 OF EACH TRANSACTION IN WHICH A PERSON SELLS FIVE OR MORE PLASTIC 5 MILK CRATES THAT SHOWS THAT THE PERSON SELLING THE PLASTIC MILK 6 CRATES HAS LAWFUL POSSESSION OR OWNERSHIP OF THE PLASTIC MILK 7 CRATES.

- 8 (2) FOR EACH TRANSACTION SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (1) OF 9 THIS SUBSECTION, THE PURCHASER SHALL:
- 10(I)VERIFY THE SELLER'S IDENTITY BY A DRIVER'S LICENSE11OR OTHER GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION; AND
- 12(II) MAKE A RECORD OF EACH TRANSACTION THAT13INCLUDES:
- 141.THE NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, AND15SIGNATURE OF THE SELLER OR THE SELLER'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE;
- 16 **2.** THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE BUYER;
- 173.A DESCRIPTION OF THE ITEMS SOLD, INCLUDING18THE NUMBER OF UNITS; AND
- 19 **4.** THE DATE OF THE TRANSACTION.
- 20 (C) THE PURCHASER SHALL KEEP THE RECORDS REQUIRED BY THIS 21 SECTION FOR 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF PURCHASE.

### 22 (D) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 23 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$100.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 2008.

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
