A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Maryland Sales Below Cost of Fluid Milk Products Act

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain milk dealers from selling or offering to sell 4 certain fluid milk products to certain entities in the State at less than a certain 5 cost; prohibiting certain milk dealers from selling certain fluid milk products in 6 combination with certain other items under certain circumstances; providing for 7 the calculation of certain costs of certain fluid milk products in a certain 8 manner; requiring certain milk dealers to present certain costs to the Secretary 9 of Agriculture for certification in a certain manner; requiring the Secretary to 10 consider certain information as confidential under certain circumstances; requiring the Secretary to enforce this Act in a certain manner; requiring the 11 Secretary to adopt certain regulations; authorizing a circuit court to enjoin a 12 certain milk dealer from certain acts in a certain manner; providing for the 13 14 intent and applicability of this Act; providing that the Maryland Sales Below Cost Act does not apply to this Act; defining certain terms; and generally 1516 relating to sales of fluid milk products in the State.

1 (C) **"DEALER" MEANS A PROCESSOR, DISTRIBUTOR, OR BROKER THAT** 2 SELLS PROCESSED MILK TO A RETAILER OR GOVERNMENTAL CUSTOMER.

3 (D) "FLUID MILK PRODUCT" MEANS A CLASS I FLUID MILK PRODUCT
4 PROCESSED BY A DEALER THAT, AT THE TIME OF ITS SALE TO A RETAILER,
5 DISTRIBUTOR, BROKER, OR GOVERNMENTAL CUSTOMER, IS PACKAGED FOR
6 RESALE TO OR CONSUMPTION BY CONSUMERS OR BOTH.

7 (E) "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL, CORPORATION, OR ANY OTHER 8 LEGAL OR COMMERCIAL ENTITY.

9 (F) "PROCESSOR" MEANS A PERSON POSSESSING A LICENSE TO 10 PURCHASE RAW MILK FOR PROCESSING INTO CLASS I FLUID MILK.

11 (G) "RAW MILK" MEANS MILK THAT HAS NOT BEEN PASTEURIZED.

(H) "RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON LOCATED IN THE STATE THAT SELLS
 OR OFFERS FOR SALE A FLUID MILK PRODUCT FOR CONSUMPTION AND NOT FOR
 RESALE.

15(I) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE OR A16DESIGNEE OF THE SECRETARY.

18 (A) THIS SUBTITLE IS NOT INTENDED TO:

19(1)**REGULATE OR LIMIT IN ANY WAY THE PRICE AT WHICH A**20**RETAILER MAY RESELL FLUID MILK PRODUCTS TO CONSUMERS; OR**

21(2)AUTHORIZE THE SECRETARY OR ANY OTHER GOVERNMENT22OFFICIAL TO REQUIRE OR REGULATE THE PRICING OF SALES OF RAW MILK.

(B) TO THE EXTENT THAT A PERSON IS BOTH A DEALER AND A
RETAILER, THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES ONLY TO THAT PERSON'S SALES AS A
DEALER.

(A) A DEALER MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER TO SELL A FLUID MILK
PRODUCT TO A RETAILER, DISTRIBUTOR, BROKER, OR STATE OR LOCAL
GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY IN THE STATE AT LESS THAN THE DEALER'S COST AS
CALCULATED UNDER THIS SECTION.

1(B)A DEALER MAY NOT SELL FLUID MILK PRODUCTS IN COMBINATION2WITH ANY OTHER ITEM OF MERCHANDISE IF THE OTHER ITEM IS GIVEN FREE OF3CHARGE OR SOLD BELOW ITS COST.

4 (C) (1) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE DEALER'S COST IS, AS
5 APPORTIONED TO EACH FLUID MILK PRODUCT SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE TO
6 A RETAILER OR GOVERNMENTAL CUSTOMER, THE SUM OF THE DEALER'S:

7 (I) BASIC COST OF RAW MILK, WHICH IS THE CERTIFIED
8 AVERAGE PER GALLON PRICE PAID BY THE DEALER FOR ALL RAW MILK
9 RECEIVED DURING THE JUST-COMPLETED CALENDAR MONTH AT THE DEALER'S
10 PLANT IN WHICH THE FLUID MILK PRODUCT WAS PRODUCED;

11(II) INGREDIENT COSTS, WHICH ARE THE CERTIFIED12AVERAGE PER OUNCE COSTS INCURRED BY THE DEALER DURING THE13JUST-COMPLETED CALENDAR MONTH FOR EACH INGREDIENT ADDED BY THE14DEALER TO CLASS I FLUID MILK IN PROCESSING FLUID MILK PRODUCTS;

(III) PACKAGE COSTS, WHICH ARE THE CERTIFIED UNIT
COSTS OF CARTONS, BOTTLES, AND OTHER CONTAINERS IN WHICH THE DEALER
PACKAGES FLUID MILK PRODUCTS FOR RESALE BY RETAILERS TO CONSUMERS,
INCURRED BY THE DEALER DURING THE JUST-COMPLETED CALENDAR
QUARTER;

A MARKUP OF A PERCENTAGE ON THE COMBINED
 BASIC COST OF RAW MILK, INGREDIENT COSTS, AND PACKAGE COSTS, TO COVER

 COSTS; OR

1 (3) (I) FOR COSTS OR PRICE TO BE CERTIFIED UNDER THIS 2 SUBSECTION, THE DEALER SHALL PRESENT THE PARTICULAR COSTS ACTUALLY 3 INCURRED BY THE DEALER DURING THE JUST-COMPLETED CALENDAR MONTH 4 TO THE SECRETARY, UNDER OATH, IN A FORM AND AT A TIME DESIGNATED BY 5 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY.

16 (B) THE SECRETARY MAY COMPEL THE PRODUCTION OF BOOKS, 17 RECORDS, AND TESTIMONY AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF 18 THE SECRETARY'S DUTIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, INCLUDING THE 19 PRODUCTION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED BY A DEALER TO ANY OTHER 20 FEDERAL OR STATE REGULATORY AUTHORITY.

21(C)**THE SECRETARY MAY EMPLOY INSPECTORS AND OTHER STAFF TO**22ENFORCE THIS SUBTITLE.

24 (A) ON COMPLAINT OF THE SECRETARY OR ANY AFFECTED PERSON, A 25 CIRCUIT COURT MAY:

26(1)ENJOIN A DEALER FROM ANY ACT PROHIBITED BY THIS27SUBTITLE; AND

28 (2) AWARD DAMAGES, COSTS, AND REASONABLE ATTORNEY'S
 29 FEES.

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1(B)IN AN ACTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF, THE COMPLAINANT NEED2NOT ALLEGE OR PROVE THAT AN ADEQUATE REMEDY AT LAW DOES NOT EXIST3OR THAT THE COMPLAINANT HAS SUFFERED ACTUAL DAMAGES.
