13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article - State Finance and Procurement

17	(a) There is a Central Collection Fund.
18 19	(b) The Central Collection Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7–302 of this article.
$\begin{array}{c} 20 \\ 21 \end{array}$	(c) The Fund shall consist of all fees collected under $\S 3-304(a)(2)$ of this subtitle.



- 1 (d) Subject to the appropriation process in the State budget **AND SUBJECT**2 **TO SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION**, the Department shall use the Fund for the expenses of operating the Central Collection Unit.
- 4 (e) The State Treasurer shall hold and the State Comptroller shall account 5 for the Fund.
- 6 (f) The Fund shall be invested and reinvested in the same manner as other 7 State funds.
- 8 (g) Investment earnings accrue to the benefit of the Fund.
- 9 (H) ANY BALANCE IN THE FUND AT THE END OF JUNE 30 OF EACH 10 FISCAL YEAR IN EXCESS OF 10% OF THE ACTUAL EXPENSES OF OPERATING THE 11 CENTRAL COLLECTION UNIT FOR THAT FISCAL YEAR REVERTS TO THE 12 GENERAL FUND.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, on or before June 30, 2009, the Governor may transfer to the General Fund \$25,000,000 of the funds in the Central Collection Fund established under § 3–306 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall be applicable to all fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2009.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
