4 (i) subject to the regulations adopted under § 2–503 of this 5 subtitle, shall encompass all units in the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative branches 6 of State government, including any unit with an independent personnel system;

7 (ii) shall include the health insurance benefit options 8 established by the Secretary; and

9 (iii) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, may 10 include any other benefit option that the Secretary considers appropriate.
