FOR the purpose of prohibiting a State or local authority from issuing a certain building permit for certain construction projects unless the site has a toilet and lavatory that meet certain requirements; requiring certain toilets to be flush toilets under certain circumstances; providing that certain provisions only apply to certain construction projects that have a certain total cost; defining a certain term; and generally relating to rest rooms at construction sites.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20(A) IN THIS SECTION, "BUILDING PERMIT" MEANS A PERMIT THAT21ALLOWS ANY BUILDING CONSTRUCTION AND IS ISSUED BY ANY STATE OR LOCAL22AUTHORITY.

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1 (1) **(B)** A STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITY MAY NOT ISSUE A BUILDING $\mathbf{2}$ PERMIT FOR A CONSTRUCTION PROJECT THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF 3 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION UNLESS THE SITE HAS: 4 **(I)** A CONVENIENT TOILET THAT IS: $\mathbf{5}$ 1. **KEPT IN SANITARY CONDITION; AND** 6 2. **PROPERLY VENTILATED; AND** $\mathbf{7}$ **(II)** A CONVENIENT LAVATORY THAT IS: 8 1. SUPPLIED WITH SOAP, CLEAN WATER, TOWELS, 9 **OR OTHER APPROVED HAND DRYING DEVICES;** 10 2. **KEPT IN SANITARY CONDITION; AND** 11 3. **PROPERLY VENTILATED.** 12(2) THE TOILETS REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 13SUBSECTION SHALL BE FLUSH TOILETS IF: 14 WATER AND SEWER LINES ARE LOCATED WITHIN 200 **(I)** 15FEET OF THE CONSTRUCTION SITE; AND 16 **(II)** FLUSH TOILETS AND SINKS ARE PROVIDED FOR OTHER 17PERSONNEL ON SITE, INCLUDING OFFICE PERSONNEL. 18 (C) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES TO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS THAT 19 HAVE A TOTAL COST OF \$500,000 OR MORE. 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

21 October 1, 2008.
