Maryland Small Business Innovation Research Matching Funds Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Small Business Innovation Research 4 Matching Funds Program in the Technology Economic Development 5 Corporation; requiring the Corporation to award certain matching grants to certain recipients of certain federal program grants in a certain manner; 6 7 authorizing the Corporation to award matching grants using certain funds; requiring an applicant for Program matching funds to submit a certain 8 9 application form and pay a nonrefundable fee established by regulation; 10 requiring the Program application form to include certain information; 11 establishing a maximum grant amount; limiting the number of matching grants a business may receive; requiring the Corporation to submit a certain annual 12 report; requiring the Corporation to adopt certain regulations in a certain 13 14 manner; stating the purpose of the Program; and generally relating to the Maryland Small Business Innovation Research Matching Funds Program. 15
