Criminal Procedure - Police Reporting - Detained Undocumented Aliens

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a police officer who encounters and detains in the 4 normal course of the officer's duties an individual who the police officer 5 determines is an undocumented alien to inform the U.S. Immigration and 6 Customs Enforcement agency of the United States Department of Homeland 7 Security of the detention as soon as possible after the police officer has detained 8 the undocumented alien; providing that this Act does not require that a police 9 officer search for an individual for the sole purpose of detaining undocumented 10 aliens; and generally relating to undocumented aliens.
