13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

16 12–508.

(a) A pharmacist may administer [an influenza vaccination] VACCINATIONS
 to an individual, in accordance with regulations adopted under subsection (c) of this
 section.

20 (b) The Board shall set reasonable fees for the administration of [an 21 influenza vaccination] **VACCINATIONS** in accordance with subsection (a) of this 22 section.

1 (c) The Board[, with the Board of Physicians and the Board of Nursing,] 2 shall [jointly] develop and adopt regulations to provide for patient safety and to 3 implement this section.
