- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a statement of need for developing, operating, establishing, relocating, or expanding a residential child care program; 4 providing certain exceptions; requiring the Department of Human Resources 5 and the Department of Juvenile Services to issue a statement of need to a 6 program; requiring the Departments to adopt certain regulations; requiring the 7 8 Departments to provide notification of certain applications in a certain manner; 9 defining certain terms; and generally relating to statements of need for residential child care programs. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 21 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 22 (2) "LICENSING AGENCY" MEANS:

1	(I) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES; AND
2	(II) THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES.
3	(3) "STATEMENT OF NEED" MEANS AN OFFICIAL CERTIFICATION
4	OF PUBLIC NEED FOR THE LOCATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A RESIDENTIAL
5	CHILD CARE PROGRAM IN A COUNTY ISSUED BY A LICENSING AGENCY UNDER
6	THIS SECTION.
7	(B) THE LICENSING AGENCIES SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS
8	GOVERNING THE ISSUANCE OF STATEMENTS OF NEED.
9	(C) AN APPLICATION MAY NOT BE SUBMITTED TO THE OFFICE AND A
10	LICENSE MAY NOT GRANTED BY A LICENSING AGENCY FOR A RESIDENTIAL
11	CHILD CARE PROGRAM UNTIL A LICENSING AGENCY ISSUES A STATEMENT OF
12	NEED FOR A RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM IN A COUNTY.
13	(D) IN ADDITION TO THE STATEMENT OF NEED REQUIRED UNDER
14	SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A STATEMENT OF NEED IS REQUIRED
15	BEFORE:
16	(1) AN EXISTING OR PREVIOUSLY LICENSED RESIDENTIAL CHILD
17	CARE PROGRAM IS RELOCATED TO ANOTHER SITE;
18	(2) THE PHYSICAL SITE OF A RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAM
19	IS EXPANDED OR RENOVATED; OR
20	(3) THE NUMBER OF PLACEMENTS IN A RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE
21	PROGRAM IS INCREASED.
22	(E) A LICENSING AGENCY SHALL PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE ISSUANCE OF
23	A STATEMENT OF NEED IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER.
24	(F) A LICENSING AGENCY SHALL HAVE NONDELEGABLE AUTHORITY TO
25	ISSUE A STATEMENT OF NEED.
26	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27	October 1, 2008.
