## Horse Racing - Purse Dedication Account - Allocation of Funds

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering certain allocations of the Purse Dedication Account under 4 the authority of the State Racing Commission that is to be established with 5 certain video lottery proceeds; requiring that funds in the Account be allocated in a certain way to thoroughbred purses at certain race tracks, the 6 7 Maryland-bred Race Fund, standardbred purses at certain race tracks, and the Standardbred Race Fund; making this Act contingent on the taking effect of 8 another Act; and generally relating to the Purse Dedication Account under the 9 10 authority of the State Racing Commission.
