1 AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Property Tax Credit - Historically Operated Amusement Park

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Worcester County or of a 4 municipal corporation in Worcester County to grant, by law, a property tax 5 6 credit for certain real property used as an amusement park; authorizing the 7 county or municipal corporation to provide, by law, for the amount and duration 8 of the credit and for certain provisions necessary to carry out the credit; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating 9 to authorization for a local property tax credit for certain property in Worcester 10 11 County that is used as a historically operated amusement park.
