1 AN ACT concerning

2 Maryland Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2008

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Budget and Management to develop and operate a specified website that includes specified information for certain 4 5 State financial assistance and expenditures; specifying certain parameters of the website; authorizing the Secretary of Budget and Management to designate 6 7 certain agencies to participate in the development, operation, or support of the 8 website; authorizing the Secretary to determine the best and most appropriate 9 data sources for the website; defining certain terms; providing that certain 10 provisions of law may not be construed to require the disclosure of certain confidential information; and generally relating to a searchable website to be 11 developed and operated by the Department of Budget and Management to 12 13 provide information to the public on State financial assistance and expenditures. 14
