### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Carroll County - Distribution of Tobacco Products to Minors - Prohibition and Penalties

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain distributions of certain tobacco products,
cigarette rolling papers, and tobacco-related coupons to minors in Carroll
County; authorizing certain defenses to a violation of this Act; establishing
certain civil penalties; and generally relating to the illegal distribution of
tobacco and tobacco-related products to minors in Carroll County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
