BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Health Occupations Section 19–202(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2005 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Health Occupations** 19–202. (a) (1) The Board consists of 11 12 members.
