1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Blue Ribbon Commission to Study Retiree Health Care Funding Options -**  
3 **Extension of Reporting and Termination Dates**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study Retiree Health  
5 Care Funding Options to issue a certain report by a certain date; altering the  
6 date by which the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study Retiree Health Care  
7 Funding Options is required to submit a certain report; extending the  
8 termination date of the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study Retiree Health Care  
9 Funding Options until a certain date; and generally relating to the reporting  
10 and termination dates of the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study Retiree Health  
11 Care Funding Options.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

9 34–201.

10 (g) (1) On or before December 31, ~~[2008]~~ **2009**, the Commission shall  
11 issue ~~a final~~ **AN INTERIM** report of its findings ~~and recommendations~~ to the Governor  
12 and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General  
13 Assembly.

14 **(2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2009, THE COMMISSION SHALL**  
15 **ISSUE A FINAL REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE**  
16 **GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT**  
17 **ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.**

18 **Chapter 433 of the Acts of 2006**

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
20 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] **4** years and, at the end of June  
21 30, [2009,] **2010**, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act  
22 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
24 July 1, 2008.
