6 extending the termination date of the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study Retiree
7 Health Care Funding Options until a certain date; and generally relating to the
8 reporting and termination dates of the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (g) On or before December 31, [2008] **2009**, the Commission shall issue a
3 final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance
4 with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

5 **Chapter 433 of the Acts of 2006**

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] **4** years and, at the end of June
8 30, [2009,] **2010**, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
9 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 July 1, 2008.
