## Certified <u>Professional,</u> Associate <del>Counselor,</del> and <u>Supervised</u> <u>Counselors</u>-Alcohol and Drug – Qualifications

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists to waive a certain requirement that an applicant for a certificate to practice as an a professional, associate, or supervised counselor—alcohol and drug complete a certain number of hours of clinically supervised experience in alcohol and drug counseling after the award of a bachelor's certain degree if the applicant has obtained certain experience approved by the Board; and generally relating to qualifications for certified professional, associate, and supervised counselors—alcohol and drug.
