9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2005. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of 14 September 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act 15 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 July 1, 2008.
