A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System – Benefit Enhancement

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the employee contribution rate for certain members of 4 the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System; altering the formula used to 5 calculate the normal service retirement allowances of certain members of the 6 Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System as of a certain date; authorizing 7 certain governmental units that participate in the Law Enforcement Officers' 8 Pension System to elect to participate in the Alternate Contributory Law 9 Enforcement Officers' Pension Selection under this Act; providing that the 10 election by a participating governmental unit to participate is irrevocable; providing for a certain purchase of service credit by certain employees of 11 participating governmental units that elect to participate in the Alternate 12 Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension Selection under this Act; and 13 14 generally relating to enhancements and modifications to pension and retirement 15benefits for members of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System.
