11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

14 4–1103.

(a) The Department shall take measures which in its judgment seem best
calculated to increase the productivity or utility of any part of the natural oyster bars
of the State, including:

- 18 (1) Identifying and using effective methods of cleaning diseased oyster
- 19 bars;
- 20 (2) Providing clean shell for the bars; [and]
- 21 (3) Using hatchery produced oysters to replant sites; AND
