## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Natural Resources – Somers Cove Marina Commission

FOR the purpose of establishing the Somers Cove Marina Commission; providing that 3 the Commission is a body politic and corporate and an instrumentality of the 4 5 State; providing that the commission is not subject to State procurement law 6 but is required to comply with the minority business enterprise requirements 7 for certain purposes; authorizing the Commission to take certain actions under 8 certain circumstances; providing for the membership and terms of members of 9 the Commission; prohibiting a member of the Commission from receiving 10 certain compensation; authorizing a member to receive certain reimbursement; providing for the election of a chair, vice chair, and secretary-treasurer and 11 vice-chair of the Commission; providing for the appointment of a 12secretary-treasurer; prohibiting a secretary-treasurer who is not a member of 13 the Commission from voting on matters before the Commission; requiring the 14 Commission to meet at certain intervals; requiring written notice to be given to 1516 each member of the Commission a certain period of time before each meeting; establishing certain quorum and voting requirements; authorizing the Secretary 17 of Natural Resources to remove a member of the Commission upon a certain 18 vote of members; providing for the selection and evaluation of an Executive 19 20Director; requiring the Secretary of Natural Resources to perform certain duties 21 under certain circumstances; requiring the Executive Director to perform 22certain duties under certain circumstances; providing that the Marina Manager 23is an employee of the State who has certain responsibilities; authorizing the 24Executive Director to execute certain leases, contracts, events, or concessions 25and contracts under certain circumstances; providing that a lease entered into

10 (b) (1) A State employee, other than the Executive Director, who is in an 11 appointed or full-time equivalent position or full-time contractual position, and who is 12 employed at Somers Cove Marina on June 1, 2008, may remain employed as a State 13 employee at the Marina subject to the authority of the Secretary under Title 1, 14 Subtitle 1 of the Natural Resources Article and the provisions of the State Personnel 15 Management System.

16 (2) If the Department and the Commission determine that the 17 Commission is financially able, the <u>The</u> Somers Cove Marina Commission shall 18 reimburse the Department of Natural Resources for the salary of the Executive 19 Director and any other <u>a</u> State employee at the Marina who remains employed in 20 <u>accordance with subsection (b)(1) of this section</u>.

(3) <u>The State shall pay the Executive Director's salary without</u>
reimbursement from the Somers Cove Marina Commission until the Secretary of
Natural Resources and the Somers Cove Marina Commission determine that the
Commission is financially able to reimburse the State for the cost of the Executive
<u>Director's salary.</u>

26 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 November 1, 2008.
