16 (d) (1) "Industrialized building" means a building assembly or system of 17 building subassemblies manufactured in its entirety, or in substantial part, off site 18 and transported to a site for installation or erection, with or without other specified 19 components, as a finished building or as part of a finished building that comprises two 20 or more industrialized building units.

(2) "Industrialized building" includes the electrical, plumbing, heating,
 ventilating, insulation, and other service systems of the building assembly or system
 of building subassemblies if the service systems are installed at the off site
 manufacture or assembly point.
