A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Stationary Engineers – Licensing Exemption – Resource**
3 **Recovery Facility Operators**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting from the requirement to be licensed by the State Board
5 of Stationary Engineers certain resource recovery facility operators who provide
6 stationary engineer services under certain circumstances; defining a certain
7 term; and generally relating to licensing of stationary engineers.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

16 6.5–301.

17 (A) Except as otherwise provided in this title, an individual shall be licensed
18 by the Board to provide stationary engineer services before the individual may provide
19 stationary engineer services in the State.

20 (B) (1) **IN THIS SUBSECTION, “RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY”**
21 **MEANS A FACILITY THAT PROCESSES SOLID WASTE TO PRODUCE VALUABLE**
22 **RESOURCES, INCLUDING STEAM, ELECTRICITY, METALS, OR REFUSE-DERIVED**
23 **FUEL.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **(2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES STATIONARY ENGINEER**
2 **SERVICES AT A RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY THAT GENERATES STEAM OR**
3 **ELECTRICITY IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO PROVIDE**
4 **STATIONARY ENGINEER SERVICES IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS CERTIFIED TO**
5 **OPERATE A RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY UNDER REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY**
6 **THE SECRETARY OF THE ENVIRONMENT.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2008.
