CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Garrett County Code of Public Local Laws – Legalization**

3 FOR the purpose of legalizing the 2005 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of
4 Garrett County, which was prepared under the direction of the Board of County
5 Commissioners of Garrett County; and generally relating to the legalization of
6 the Code of Public Local Laws of Garrett County.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
8 MARYLAND, That:

9 (1) The 2005 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Garrett
10 County, being Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, published
11 under the direction of the Board of County Commissioners, is legalized;

12 (2) Any pocket or loose-leaf supplement to the 2005 Code of Public
13 Local Laws of Garrett County that has been or may be published under the direction
14 of the Board of County Commissioners of Garrett County is legalized;

15 (3) The 2005 Code of Public Local Laws of Garrett County shall
16 contain all public local laws relating to Garrett County contained in the 1985 edition
17 and 2001 supplement of that code and those public local laws relating to Garrett
18 County passed by the General Assembly of Maryland during the 2001 through 2008
19 sessions of the General Assembly; and

1 (4) The 2005 Code of Public Local Laws of Garrett County shall be
2 deemed and taken in all courts of the State and by all public officials of the State and
3 of the political subdivisions of the State to be evidence of the public local laws of
4 Garrett County.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 July 1, 2008.
