

CHAPTER 46

(House Bill 163)

AN ACT concerning

Howard County – Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board – Qualifications for Membership

Ho. Co. 15-08

FOR the purpose of altering the qualifications for membership on the Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board in Howard County; prohibiting a member of the Hearing Board from being employed by the Howard County government; and generally relating to the Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board in Howard County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

15-107.1.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(4) “Hearing Board” means the Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board in Howard County.

(d) (1) A Hearing Board member may not hold another public office or be employed by [a public body] **THE HOWARD COUNTY GOVERNMENT**.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
