AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations - State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators - Minimum Age Requirement

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

9 - 302.

- (a) To qualify for a license, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
 - (b) The applicant shall be of good moral character.
 - (c) The applicant shall be at least [18] **21** years old.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
