

CHAPTER 84

(House Bill 697)

AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations – State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators – Minimum Age Requirement

FOR the purpose of altering the minimum age for licensure as a nursing home administrator; and generally relating to the minimum age requirement for licensure as a nursing home administrator.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

9–302.

(a) To qualify for a license, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.

(b) The applicant shall be of good moral character.

(c) The applicant shall be at least [18] **21** years old.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
