Senate Bill 869 (Senator Pugh) Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Baltimore City Public Schools - High School Students - Voter Education

This bill expresses the intent of the General Assembly that the teachers of high school students in Baltimore City public schools inform their students of the federal, State, and Baltimore City election processes and the importance of registering to vote and exercising the right to vote.
