AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 970

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “market” insert “in the county; requiring that certain persons be certified by an approved alcohol awareness program and be present at a farmers’ market in the county during certain hours”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 1, strike the brackets; strike beginning with “**EXCEPT**” in line 1 down through “**NO**” in line 2; in line 22, after “(I)” insert “**THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY TO WINERY SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS ISSUED FOR USE AT FARMERS’ MARKETS IN PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY.**”

(II)”;

in line 23, strike “**24**” and substitute “**12**”; in line 24, strike “**PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY**” and substitute “**THE COUNTY**”; in line 27, strike “(II)” and substitute “(III)”; and after line 28, insert:

“(IV) AT A FARMERS’ MARKET, THE FARMERS’ MARKET ADMINISTRATOR OR THE ADMINISTRATOR’S DESIGNEE AND EACH HOLDER OF A WINERY SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT OR THE HOLDER’S DESIGNEE:

1. SHALL BE CERTIFIED BY AN APPROVED ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROGRAM; AND

2. SHALL BE PRESENT DURING THE HOURS WHEN ALCOHOL MAY BE SOLD.”.
