AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 173  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, after line 29, insert:

“(B) “ATHLETE” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PARTICIPATES IN AN ATHLETIC ACTIVITY.

“(C) “ATHLETIC ACTIVITY” MEANS EXERCISE, RECREATION, SPORT, COMPETITION, OR GAME THAT:

(1) REQUIRES PHYSICAL STRENGTH, RANGE OF MOTION, FLEXIBILITY, CONTROL, SPEED, STAMINA, OR AGILITY; AND

(2) IS ASSOCIATED WITH AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OR A PROFESSIONAL, AMATEUR, OR RECREATIONAL SPORTS CLUB OR ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION.”;

in lines 30 and 34, strike “(B)” and “(C)”, respectively, and substitute “(D)” and “(E)”, respectively; in lines 30 and 31, strike “OR CONDITION SUSTAINED BY AN INDIVIDUAL”; in line 31, strike “THE INDIVIDUAL’S” and substitute “AN ATHLETE’S”; and in lines 32 and 33, strike “SPORTS, GAMES, RECREATION, EXERCISE, OR OTHER ACTIVITIES” and substitute “AN ATHLETIC ACTIVITY”.

On page 3, in lines 1, 3, 6, 8, 10, and 13, strike “(D)”, “(E)”, “(F)”, “(G)”, “(H)”, and “(I)”, respectively, and substitute “(F)”, “(G)”, “(H)”, “(I)”, “(J)”, and “(K)”, respectively.

On page 4, in line 1, after “**CHIROPRACTIC**” insert “, INCLUDING ADJUSTMENTS, MANIPULATION, OR HIGH VELOCITY MOBILIZATIONS OF THE SPINE OR EXTREMITIES”; in line 5, strike “**OR**”; in line 7, after “**DISEASE**” insert “; OR”

(III) EXCEPT FOR THE CONDITIONING OF AN ATHLETE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A TREATING PHYSICIAN, THE TREATMENT, REHABILITATION, OR RECONDITIONING OF NONATHLETIC INJURIES OR DISEASE”;

in lines 8 and 18, strike “**(J)**” and “**(K)**”, respectively, and substitute “(L)” and “(M)”, respectively; strike beginning with “**ACADEMIC**” in line 9 down through “**ACTIVITY**,” in line 11 and substitute “ATHLETIC ACTIVITY, AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION,”; in line 14, after “**CORPORATION**,” insert “OR”; in line 15, strike the semicolon and substitute a period; and strike lines 16 and 17 in their entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 19, strike “**EIGHT**” and substitute “11”.

On page 6, in line 9, strike “**AND**” and substitute:

“(4) ONE LICENSED PHYSICAL THERAPIST;

“(5) ONE LICENSED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST; AND”;

and strike line 10 in its entirety and substitute:

“(6) TWO CONSUMER MEMBERS.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 8, strike beginning with “IS” in line 10 down through “BY” in line 12 and substitute “REPRESENTS THAT ENTITY:”

(I) AT AN ATHLETIC EVENT IN THE STATE;

(II) FOR A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED 45 DAYS  
WITHIN A CALENDAR YEAR; AND

(III) BY”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 17, in line 14, strike “two members” and substitute “one athletic trainer member and one physician member”; in line 15, strike “three members” and substitute “one athletic trainer member, one consumer member, and the physical therapist member”; in the same line, strike “and”; in line 16, strike “three members” and substitute “one physician member, the chiropractor member, and the occupational therapist member”; and in the same line, after “2012” insert “; and”

(4) one athletic trainer member, one physician member, and one consumer member in 2013”.
