AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 303
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 5, strike “defining a certain term; altering a certain definition;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 11, strike in their entirety lines 5 through 21, inclusive, and substitute:

“(a) In this section, “offense” means a moving violation committed by an individual who:

(1) [Holds] **HELD** a provisional license under § 16–111 of this title **ON THE DATE THE VIOLATION WAS COMMITTED;**

(2) Was convicted of, or granted a probation before judgment under § 6–220 of the Criminal Procedure Article for, the violation; and

(3) Was not eligible for a license under § 16–111.1 of this title at the time of the violation.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 12, strike beginning with the colon in line 2 down through “DAYS” in line 8 and substitute “SUSPEND THE OFFENDER’S LICENSE FOR UP TO 30 DAYS”; and strike beginning with “IMPOSE” in line 21 down through “DAYS” in line 23 and substitute “RESTRICT THE OFFENDER FROM DRIVING WITH A PASSENGER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS UNTIL THE OFFENDER OBTAINS A DRIVER’S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER § 16–111.1 OF THIS TITLE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 13, strike in their entirety lines 12 through 18, inclusive, and substitute:

“(2) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, a holder of a provisional driver’s license who is under the age of 18 years may not drive a motor vehicle with a passenger under the age of 18 years.”;

and in line 27, after “stepbrother” insert “, OR COUSIN”.
