# AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Kipke" and substitute ", Kipke, Bartlett, Barve, Boteler, Cardin, Doory, Elmore, Frick, George, Gilchrist, Hixson, Howard, Ivey, Kaiser, Myers, Olszewski, Rice, Ross, Shank, Stukes, F. Turner, and Walker"; in line 6, after "specifications;" insert "providing that the specifications may not preclude the use of certain products that are regulated by a certain federal law and shall allow multiple avenues for obtaining green product cleaning supplies certification;".

# AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 25, strike "INCLUDES" and substitute "MEANS".

### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 9, insert:

# "(III) THE SPECIFICATIONS DRAFTED BY A COUNTY BOARD UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH:

- 1. MAY NOT PRECLUDE THE USE WHEN NECESSARY
  OF A DISINFECTANT, DISINFECTING CLEANER, SANITIZER, OR OTHER
  ANTIMICROBIAL PRODUCT REGULATED BY THE FEDERAL INSECTICIDE,
  FUNGICIDE, AND RODENTICIDE ACT UNDER 7 U.S.C. § 136 ET SEQ.; AND
- 2. SHALL ALLOW FOR MULTIPLE AVENUES TO OBTAIN GREEN PRODUCT CLEANING SUPPLIES CERTIFICATION, INCLUDING:

- A. THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY'S DESIGN FOR THE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM (DFE);
- B. GREEN SEAL, GREEN LABEL, ENVIRONMENTAL CHOICE, OR U.S. GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL; AND
- C. ANY OTHER ACCREDITATION THE COUNTY BOARD DETERMINES TO BE APPROPRIATE.".
