AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 863

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "requiring" in line 4 down through "self-supporting;" in line 8; strike beginning with "authorizing" in line 10 down through "payments;" in line 12 and substitute "requiring the Workers' Compensation Commission to conduct a certain study; requiring the Commission to establish a certain workgroup comprised of certain stakeholders; requiring the Commission to report its findings and recommendations by a certain date to certain committees;"; in line 17, after "9–681(e)" insert "and (j)"; and in line 22, strike "9–681(j) and".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 13, strike the brackets; and strike beginning with "; AND" in line 15 down through "INDIVIDUAL" in line 17.

On page 3, in line 8, strike "\$45,000" and substitute "\$75,000"; in line 15, strike "\$60,000" and substitute "\$75,000"; strike in their entirety lines 16 through 30, inclusive; in line 31, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike "(**F**)".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 10, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) (1) The Workers' Compensation Commission shall conduct a study on the death benefit provisions in §§ 9–678 through 9–686 of the Labor and Employment Article.
 - (2) The study shall determine legislative changes that would:

(Over)

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- (i) provide fair and equitable benefits to wholly dependent individuals and partially dependent individuals; and
- (ii) provide for coordination among all of the death benefit provisions.
- (b) In conducting its study, the Commission shall establish a workgroup that is comprised of representatives of the various stakeholders, including representatives of:
 - (1) the Commission;
 - (2) labor;
 - (3) defense counsel;
 - (4) counsel for claimants;
 - (5) employers, including a representative of small business;
- (6) workers' compensation insurance companies, including a representative of the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund;
 - (7) <u>local governments; and</u>
 - (8) any other person that the Commission considers appropriate.
- (c) On or before December 1, 2009, the Commission shall report, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, its findings and recommendations, including draft legislation to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Economic Matters Committee.";

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in line 15, strike "October 1, 2009" and substitute "July 1, 2009"; and in lines 11 and 14, strike "2." and "3.", respectively, and substitute "3." and "4.", respectively.
