AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1348  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, after the first “of” insert “repealing certain exceptions under which certain retirees of the Judges’ Retirement System may be reemployed without being subject to a certain earnings offset to their retirement allowance;”; in line 5, after “State;” insert “repealing a certain requirement to reduce certain retirement benefits of certain retirees of the Judges’ Retirement System by a certain amount if the retirees earn an additional retirement benefit under certain circumstances; prohibiting certain retirees of the Judges’ Retirement System from being rehired within a certain period of time under certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 16 through 20, inclusive; and in line 21, strike “(b)” and substitute “(A)”.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 13 through 20, inclusive; after line 20, insert:

**“(B) A RETIREE MAY NOT BE REHIRED WITHIN 45 DAYS OF THE DATE THE INDIVIDUAL RETIRED IF THE INDIVIDUAL’S CURRENT EMPLOYER IS ANY UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT AND THE INDIVIDUAL’S EMPLOYER AT THE TIME OF THE INDIVIDUAL’S LAST SEPARATION FROM EMPLOYMENT WITH THE STATE BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL COMMENCED RECEIVING A SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE WAS ALSO A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.”;**

and in line 22, strike “October” and substitute “July”.
