AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1538
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Rudolph” and substitute “Delegates Rudolph, Benson, Bromwell, Donoghue, Elliott, Hammen, Hubbard, Kach, Kipke, Krebs, Kullen, McDonough, Morhaim, Nathan–Pulliam, Pena–Melnik, Pendergrass, Riley, Tarrant, V. Turner, and Weldon”; in line 4, strike “issue” and substitute “limit the issuance of”; and in line 13, after “manner;” insert “requiring the Maryland Insurance Administration, in consultation with a certain nonprofit health service plan, to report certain information to the Governor and certain legislative committees on or before a certain date;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 7 through 9, inclusive, and substitute:

“(B) A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN MAY LIMIT THE ISSUANCE OF A HIGH DEDUCTIBLE PLAN TO:”;

in lines 11 and 17, in each instance, strike “**DEPENDENTS**” and substitute “**FAMILY MEMBERS**”; and in line 27, strike “**ENROLLMENT**” and substitute “**MARKETING**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 32, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before January 1, 2012, the Maryland Insurance Administration, in consultation with a nonprofit health service plan that issues high deductible health plans and limited benefit health insurance contracts under § 14-128 of the Insurance Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State

(Over)

Government Article, the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee on:

(1) the number of individuals who receive health care coverage under a plan or contract issued under § 14-128; and

(2) the potential to expand the pilot project established under this Act to other jurisdictions of the State.”.

On page 4, in lines 1 and 5, strike “2.” and “3.”, respectively, and substitute “3.” and “4.”, respectively.
