AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1569
(Third Reading File Bill)

On page 18, in line 33, strike “1” and substitute “2”.

On page 19, in line 14, strike “1” and substitute “2”; and strike beginning with “require” in line 19 down through “raised” in line 21 and substitute “examine:”

- (a) the likelihood the plaintiff will succeed on the merits;
- (b) the balance of convenience determined by whether greater injury would be done to the defendant by granting the stay than would result from its refusal;
- (c) whether the plaintiff will suffer irreparable injury unless the stay is granted; and
- (d) the public interest in granting the stay”.
