15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "IMPERVIOUS SURFACE" INCLUDES:
- 20 (I) STRUCTURES, BUILDINGS, DWELLING UNITS, ROADS,
- 21 PARKING LOTS, DRIVEWAYS; AND

1 2 3	(II) AREAS THAT ARE COVERED WITH GRAVEL, STONE, SHELL, IMPERMEABLE DECKING, PAVERS, OR ANY OTHER IMPERVIOUS MATERIAL.
4	(2) "IMPERVIOUS SURFACE" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
5 6	(I) A FENCE OR WALL THAT IS LESS THAN 1 FOOT IN WIDTH THAT HAS NOT BEEN CONSTRUCTED WITH A FOOTER;
7	(II) A WOOD MULCH PATHWAY; OR
8	(III) A DECK WITH GAPS TO ALLOW WATER TO PASS FREELY.
9 10 11	(B) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING, SHALL DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A DATABASE OF IMPERVIOUS SURFACE IN THE STATE.
12 13 14	(C) EACH COUNTY SHALL REPORT THE AMOUNT OF ITS IMPERVIOUS SURFACE TO THE DEPARTMENT IN A MANNER AND ACCORDING TO A SCHEDULE DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
15 16	(D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
