- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from buying or offering to buy a minor for money, property, or anything else of value; establishing that certain penalties 4 5 apply to a violation of this Act; establishing that a person who violates this Act is subject to a provision of law that authorizes the State to institute a 6 7 prosecution for the offense at any time and, for purposes of the Maryland Constitution, that deems the person to have committed an offense the 8 9 punishment for which is confinement in the penitentiary, and who may reserve a point or question for a certain in banc review; and generally relating to the 10 crime of buying a minor. 11

- 1 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding 3 \$10,000 or both for each violation.
- 4 (c) A person who violates this section is subject to \S 5–106(b) of the Courts 5 Article.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2009.
