- 4 (a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of the 5 Maryland Vehicle Law unless the violation:
- 6 (1) Is declared to be a felony by the Maryland Vehicle Law or by any other law of this State; or
- 8 (2) Is punishable by a civil penalty under the applicable provision of 9 the Maryland Vehicle Law.
- 10 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
