# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## **Education – Floating Teacher Pilot Program**

FOR the purpose of establishing the Floating Teacher Pilot Program in certain
counties; requiring certain county boards of education to select certain schools
to participate in the Pilot Program based on certain criteria; requiring the State
Department of Education to reimburse certain county boards for certain
expenses; requiring the Department to submit a certain report on or before a
certain date; defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act;
and generally relating to the Floating Teacher Pilot Program.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## **Article – Education**

19(A)(1)IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE20MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "FLOATING TEACHER" MEANS A TEACHER, OTHER THAN A
 REGULARLY ASSIGNED CLASSROOM TEACHER, ASSIGNED TO ASSIST A STUDENT
 WHO HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY SCHOOL STAFF TO REQUIRE ADDITIONAL

15 16 17	(C) THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION FOR BALTIMORE CITY, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL EACH SELECT THREE UNDERPERFORMING SCHOOLS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PILOT PROGRAM.

24 25 26	(F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE A COUNTY BOARD THAT PARTICIPATES IN THE PILOT PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION FOR THE COST OF IMPLEMENTING THE PILOT PROGRAM.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31, 2011, the State Department of Education shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly regarding the effectiveness of the Floating Teacher Pilot Program.

July 1, 2009. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 6 months and, at the
end of December 31, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
