11 WHEREAS, Cesar Estrada Chavez was a farm worker and leader who fought 12 for civil rights, economic and environmental justice, and worker rights in the United 13 States; and

WHEREAS, He is widely recognized as one of the great civil rights leaders in
 United States history; and

18 WHEREAS, Because of his life's work, six other states have enacted laws
19 establishing a Cesar Chavez commemorative day; now, therefore,
