# 2 Education – Maryland's Preschool for All Business Plan – Final Report 3 Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to consult with and 5 accept comments from certain county superintendents and certain local 6 governing bodies regarding the Maryland's Preschool for All Business Plan before preparing and publishing a certain version of a certain Business Plan; 7 requiring the Department to submit to the Governor and General Assembly a 8 9 copy of a certain report that includes certain information on or before a certain date; prohibiting the Department from implementing the finalized Business Plan 10 unless the Department identifies a certain funding source; defining certain 11 terms; and generally relating to final report requirements for the Maryland's 12 Preschool for All Business Plan. 13

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1  $\mathbf{2}$ MARYLAND, That: In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 3 (a) (1)(2)"Business Plan" means the Maryland's Preschool for All Business 4  $\mathbf{5}$ Plan: A Draft Proposal published by the State Department of Education in September 6 2008. 7 (3)"County superintendents" includes the Chief Executive Officer of the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners. 8 9 "Department" means the State Department of Education. (4)10 (b) The Department shall consult with and accept comments from county superintendents and local governing bodies regarding the contents, costs, and staged 11 implementation of the draft Business Plan before preparing and publishing a final 12 version of the Business Plan. 13 On or before December 1, 2009, the Department shall submit to the 14 (c) 15Governor, and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly, a copy of the finalized Business Plan that includes: 16 17(1)any feedback and comments from county superintendents and local governing bodies under subsection (b) of this section; 18 19 (2)a cost projection for the staged implementation of the finalized 20Business Plan: 21an evaluation of the State's mandated pre-Kindergarten income (3)eligibility level; 2223a comparison of income eligibility levels for preschool services in (4)24Maryland and other states: the feasibility of expanding the State's mandated income eligibility 25(5)26levels for preschool services, utilizing all available funding sources; 27the feasibility of and a cost projection for identifying (6) pre-Kindergarten students attending public schools as enrolled students under § 285-202(a)(6) of the Education Article; 29 30 (6) (7) the level of participation in preschool services by the eligible 31 population in the State; and
