A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Education – Maryland's Preschool for All Business Plan – Final Report Requirements

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to consult with and 5 accept comments from certain county superintendents and certain local governing bodies regarding the Maryland's Preschool for All Business Plan 6 before preparing and publishing a certain version of a certain Business Plan; 7 8 requiring the Department to submit to the Governor and General Assembly a 9 copy of a certain report that includes certain information on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to final report requirements 10 for the Maryland's Preschool for All Business Plan. 11

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) "Business Plan" means the Maryland's Preschool for All Business
Plan: A Draft Proposal published by the State Department of Education in September
2008.

- 18 (3) "County superintendents" includes the Chief Executive Officer of
 19 the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners.

- (4) "Department" means the State Department of Education.

(b) The Department shall consult with and accept comments from county
 superintendents and local governing bodies regarding the contents, costs, and staged
 implementation of the draft Business Plan before preparing and publishing a final
 version of the Business Plan.

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1 (c) On or before December 1, 2009, the Department shall submit to the 2 Governor, and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the 3 General Assembly, a copy of the finalized Business Plan that includes:

- 4 (1) any feedback and comments from county superintendents and local 5 governing bodies under subsection (b) of this section;
- 6 (2) a cost projection for the staged implementation of the finalized 7 Business Plan;
- 8 (3) an evaluation of the State's mandated pre-Kindergarten income 9 eligibility level;
- 10 (4) a comparison of income eligibility levels for preschool services in
 11 Maryland and other states;
- 12 (5) the feasibility of expanding the State's mandated income eligibility
 13 levels for preschool services, utilizing all available funding sources;
- 14 (6) the level of participation in preschool services by the eligible 15 population in the State; and
- 16 (7) the level of demand for access to preschool services by the 17 noneligible population in the State.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2009.
