5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the 6 provisions of Section 1 of this Act, an entity licensed to offer instant bingo under a 7 commercial bingo license as of July 1, 2007, or by a qualified organization as defined in 8 § 13–201 of this article on the premises of the qualified organization may continue to 9 operate a game of instant bingo in the same manner using electronic machines until 10 July 1, [2009] **2011**, provided that:

11 (a) [the machines have been in operation for a 1-year period ending 12 December 31, 2007;

(b)] the entity does not operate more than the number of electronic machines
operated as of February 28, 2008; and

15 [(c)] (B) the conduct of the gaming and operation of the machines is 16 consistent with all other provisions of the Criminal Law Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJune 1, 2009.
