A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Capital Projects – High Performance Buildings – Green Globe Rating**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “high performance building” for purposes
4 of certain requirements for certain State capital projects to include a building
5 that achieves at least a certain globe rating; and generally relating to the
6 construction and renovation of high performance buildings by the State.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

15 3–602.1.

16 (a) (2) “High performance building” means a building that:

17 (i) meets or exceeds the current version of the U.S. Green
18 Building Council’s LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green
19 Building Rating System Silver rating; [or]

20 (II) **ACHIEVES AT LEAST A TWO GLOBE RATING ACCORDING**
21 **TO THE GREEN GLOBES PROGRAM AS ADOPTED BY THE GREEN BUILDING**
22 **INITIATIVE; OR**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 [(ii)] (III) achieves at least a comparable numeric rating
2 according to a nationally recognized, accepted, and appropriate numeric sustainable
3 development rating system, guideline, or standard approved by the Secretaries of
4 Budget and Management and General Services.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 July 1, 2009.
