#### Health Care Malpractice – Noneconomic Damages

FOR the purpose of altering certain limitations on noneconomic damages for a
personal injury action and a wrongful death action concerning health care
malpractice for a cause of action arising on or after a certain date; and generally
relating to noneconomic damages in personal injury and wrongful death actions
concerning health care malpractice.

13SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF14MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

17 (b) (1) (i) Except as provided in paragraph [(2)(ii)] (2)(III) of this 18 subsection, an award or verdict under this subtitle for noneconomic damages for a 19 cause of action arising between January 1, 2005, and December 31, 2008, inclusive, 20 may not exceed \$650,000.

(II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2)(III) OF THIS
 SUBSECTION, AN AWARD OR VERDICT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR
 NONECONOMIC DAMAGES FOR A CAUSE OF ACTION ARISING BETWEEN JANUARY
 1, 2009, AND SEPTEMBER 30, 2009, INCLUSIVE, MAY NOT EXCEED \$665,000.

1 (III) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3)(III) OF THIS 2 SUBSECTION, AN AWARD OR VERDICT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR 3 NONECONOMIC DAMAGES FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR WRONGFUL DEATH FOR A 4 CAUSE OF ACTION ARISING ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2009, MAY NOT EXCEED 5 \$710,000.

6 [(ii)] (IV) The limitation on noneconomic damages provided 7 under subparagraph [(i)] (III) of this paragraph shall increase by \$15,000 on 8 [January] OCTOBER 1 of each year beginning [January 1, 2009] OCTOBER 1, 2010. 9 The increased amount shall apply to causes of action arising between [January 1 and 10 December 31] OCTOBER 1 of that year AND SEPTEMBER 30 OF THE FOLLOWING 11 YEAR, inclusive.

# (2) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY TO AN AWARD OR A VERDICT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR A CAUSE OF ACTION ARISING BETWEEN JANUARY 1, 2005, AND SEPTEMBER 30, 2009, INCLUSIVE.

15 [(i)] (II) Except as provided in subparagraph [(ii)] (III) of this 16 paragraph, the limitation under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall apply in the 17 aggregate to all claims for personal injury and wrongful death arising from the same 18 medical injury, regardless of the number of claims, claimants, plaintiffs, beneficiaries, 19 or defendants.

[(ii)] (III) If there is a wrongful death action in which there are two or more claimants or beneficiaries, whether or not there is a personal injury action arising from the same medical injury, the total amount awarded for noneconomic damages for all actions may not exceed 125% of the limitation established under paragraph (1) of this subsection, regardless of the number of claims, claimants, plaintiffs, beneficiaries, or defendants.

26 (3) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES TO AN AWARD OR A VERDICT
 27 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR A CAUSE OF ACTION ARISING ON OR AFTER
 28 OCTOBER 1, 2009.

(II) THE LIMITATION ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPH
 (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL APPLY IN A PERSONAL INJURY ACTION TO
 EACH DIRECT VICTIM OF TORTIOUS CONDUCT AND ALL PERSONS WHO CLAIM
 INJURY BY OR THROUGH THAT VICTIM.

(III) IN A WRONGFUL DEATH ACTION IN WHICH THERE ARE
 TWO OR MORE CLAIMANTS OR BENEFICIARIES, AN AWARD OR A VERDICT FOR
 NONECONOMIC DAMAGES MAY NOT EXCEED 150% OF THE LIMITATION
 ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION, REGARDLESS
